



### SJCA transition to FACTS Common Enrollment Questions

### As a returning family, do I need to apply for the parish grant?

No, all returning families automatically receive a parish grant.

#### Will ECC families receive financial assistance?

ECC families (including the PK programs at SFX and St. James) are not eligible for financial aid.

## If something unforeseen arises financially during the school year (major medical event, loss of job, etc.), whom do I contact?

Families dealing with unforeseen financial emergencies need to contact the Dean of their campus first.

# Will FACTS be able to bill us as we have been billed in the past and in the same increments of time (monthly, weekly)?

FACTS offers several payment plan options. Each family will have the opportunity to choose a plan that best fits their budget. FACTS charges a one-time set-up fee per family.

## Will FACTS be set up to receive payment for incidentals such as aftercare and lunch?

Yes, these are a part of the FACTS system.

#### Will you accept checks or cash?

Yes, checks and cash will be accepted, however, they must be hand delivered to SJCA offices. Please call 816-375-5180 to arrange a time to drop off your payment.

# Will I still receive separate tuition invoices for elementary and high school? No, families will receive a consolidated invoice through the FACTS system.

### Will I be able to enroll all of my children at one time?

Yes, families will be able to enroll children at all five campuses. For example, you may enroll your  $6^{\text{\tiny th}}$ ,  $8^{\text{\tiny th}}$ , and  $10^{\text{\tiny th}}$  graders at the same time. All campuses are a part of the FACTS system.

### **Are FACTS and Sycamore Education similar?**

Yes, FACTS is a school information system, just like Sycamore. All five campuses are part of FACTS, so parents can see their elementary and high school-age children on one site.

**NOTE: SFX Families** will see that their family tuition amount is consolidated rather than delineated by student.
